

Online Privacy Policy

The Southern California Tennis Association Foundation ("the Foundation") protects your privacy.

The Foundation is aware that you are cautious about the information you share on our site and how we use it. We fully appreciate your concern for security. Listed in this document are the various ways that the Foundation registers your information, and uses it. This includes the information collected from you when you visit www.SCTAFoundation.org. By visiting www.SCTAFoundation.org you are accepting the Terms and Conditions described in this Privacy Policy.

What kind of personal identifiable information is collected from me when I visit the website?

When you visit our website, you may provide us with personal information (such as name, address, email address, telephone numbers and/or credit/debit card information) that you knowingly choose to disclose, which is collected on an individual basis for various purposes. These purposes include requesting further information from us about grants, submitting grant applications, making requests, submitting a form on our website, or simply asking a question. We receive and store any information you enter on our website or give to us in any other way.

We ask for personal information so that we can fulfill your request and reply to you. This information is retained and used in accordance with existing laws, rules, regulations, and other policies. The Foundation does not collect personal information from you unless you provide it to us.

If you choose not to provide any information, we may not be able to fulfill your request, but you will still be free to browse the other sections of the websites owned and administered by the Foundation. This means that you can visit our site without telling us who you are or revealing any personally identifiable information about yourself.

How does the Foundation use the information I provide?

When you supply information about yourself for a specific purpose, we use the information for only that purpose (such as to provide the information you have requested). For example, you may be asked to give us individual details to receive information, to submit a grant application, or to join our email mailing list.

We use email addresses provided by you to send monthly updates on your grant application status, or to send you newsletters. However, you can opt out of receiving these newsletters. We use return email addresses to answer emails we receive. Such addresses are not used for any other purpose and are not shared with any third parties. The Foundation does not sell, rent, give-away or share its e-mail addresses or other information with outside sources.

How does the Foundation ensure data security?

Personally identifiable information is stored on our server and is not publicly accessible. Further, personally identifiable information is only accessed by the Foundation personnel on a "need to know" basis. To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the correct use of information, we have put in place appropriate security procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. Additionally, sensitive data such as credit card numbers is encrypted to provide an additional level of security.

How do I update my information?

If you ever need to update the information provided by you on our website, write to us at lmilan@scta.usta.com with relevant changes made to your details. We will update your details at once.

Is any anonymous information collected about me on the website?

Anonymous information is collected for every visitor to this site. IP numbers are not stored, but are temporarily used to determine domain type and in some cases, geographic region. We do not make any association between this information and a visitor's identity.

How does SCTAFoundation.org use Cookies?

Cookies are simple text files stored by your web browser that provide a method of distinguishing among visitors to the website. The Foundation uses cookies to identify your browser as you visit pages on the Foundation website or sites in the Foundation media network. Cookies created on your computer by using our website do not contain personally identifiable information and do not compromise your privacy or security. Cookies allow the Foundation to gather anonymous information.

Online Registration Information

You will provide us with information about yourself and your organization when you register for grant applications, or any other purpose. This information is not used for any other purpose than to fulfill your request and is not shared with outside parties. However, visitors should be aware that information collected through the Foundation website may be subject to examination and inspection if such information is a public record or not otherwise protected from disclosure.
